## TRADE DISPUTE WITH REACH GROUP

Our independent scrutineers' report, as required in accordance with section 231B of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992, for the above ballot which closed on **Friday**, **12 August 2022**, is as follows:-
